Call to Audition

The Cape Town Chamber Choir is looking for New Members!

The Cape Town Chamber Choir, founded in **2010** under the direction of **Leon Starker**, brings together around 30 singers ranging in age from their 20s to 70s. United by a passion for traditional a cappella music, the choir is known for its warm, expressive sound and diverse repertoire spanning sacred, folk, and contemporary works. Over the years, it has become a cherished part of Cape Town's choral community.

Step 1: Choose your Voice Part

Soprano (I / II)

A **soprano** is the highest female (or treble) singing voice type.

Alto (I / II)

Lower female voice type, typically ranging from **F3 to D5**, with a **warm, resonant timbre**

Tenor (I / II)

Highest natural male voice type.

Bass (I / II)

A **Bass** is the lowest of the male singing voice type.

Step 2: Prepare and submit a video recording made on your mobile device.

You may use WeTransfer / Smash if the file is too large. You may also send us a Google Drive / YouTube Link to your audition video. If selected, you will be **invited** to an in-person audition on the following dates:

What to include in your audition video?

- **Tell us about yourself!** Briefly share your choral experience, including your most recent ensemble performance.
- **Tell us about your current schedule, and if you time for the following:** **Weekly Monday evening rehearsals from 7–9 PM**, term concerts, and occasional Sunday services performances.
- **Sing Silent Night without accompaniment** In a key that is comfortable for your voice. You may sing it in any language of your choice.
